



# Health & Safety Policy Statement

## Our statement of general health & safety policy is:

- To assess and manage associated risks across the full lifecycle of our projects to ensure that risks are as low as reasonably practicable;
- To comply as a minimum with legislation and associated codes of practice and endeavour to improve on the performance standards they specify by adopting a risk-based approach to design, construction and operations of facilities;
- To implement appropriate health, safety and environment management systems;
- To introduce and maintain an active programme to develop security awareness and responsibility among all employees and contractors;
- To continually improve our health, safety and environmental performance so that work-related ill health and incidents are reduced and environmental emissions, waste and the use of energy are decreased relative to activity;
- To ensure that health, safety and environmental performance is the responsibility of all staff and involve and consult employees and, where appropriate, their representatives;
- To provide direction, training and, where appropriate, supervision to enable all staff to meet their responsibility to work safely and with due consideration to health;
- To develop and maintain effective contingency plans, where appropriate in conjunction with the authorities and emergency services;
- Through the proactive involvement of our management, encourage our contractors and partners to demonstrate the same level of commitment as Britannia Marine in endeavouring to continuously improve standards of health, safety and environmental performance;
- To make available appropriate resources to implement this policy; and
- To ensure compliance with this policy through a process of education, review and audit.
